**Mallets:**

Please be prepared to perform both of these scales at the specified tempo, preferably from memory.

## Set Pieces

Please prepare these pieces to video record and submit as per audition instructions. You do not need to perform them from memory. You may write on this sheet if you would like.

Set pieces 1 and 2 are required.

Set piece 3 is optional as we understand that not all students have access to a drum kit at this time. You will not be penalised in any way if you do not perform it, but it is in your interest to perform it if you are able to do so.

### Set Piece 1 - Mallets:
